Chinese Garden Society auction.



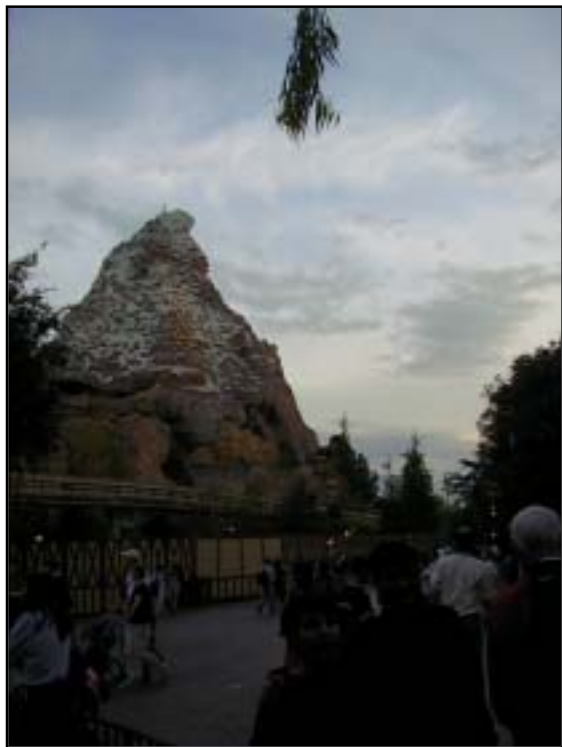
Pigletté and BoBo decide to pose near the statue for which the complex is named:

Who is the nice person feeding us that yummy ice cream?



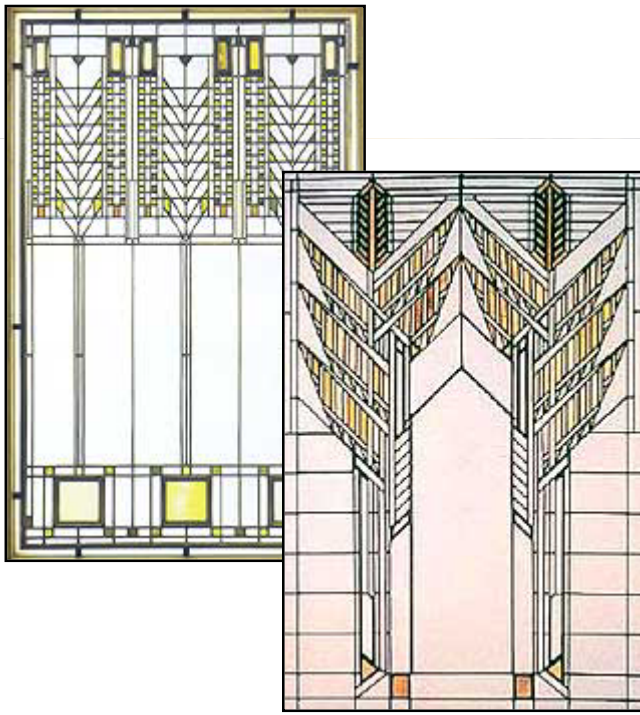
Time for Pigletté and BoBo to say goodbye to the “Land of Walt”. What silly-looking busses take us back to the Edsel!
